You will be charged a full fee for any non-members in your group. Reciprocal play is subject to availability as determined by the receiving club. Consult with the Pro Shop for the full details of the program.

Hole-in-One Insurance Policy

1. \$2 is charged to each golfing member every time a member or his or her guest (in a sanctioned HCC tournament) scores a hole-in-one.
2. Guests scoring a hole-in-one during regular, non-tournament play are not covered by this insurance policy.
3. Proceeds from the Insurance Fund will be used for the Player scoring hole-in-one to receive a memento from the Pro Shop as well as recognition on the Club's Hole-In-One plaques.
4. The player, and a witness, must report the hole-in-one to the Pro Shop at the completion of the round.
5. The Pro Shop will notify the House and the celebration will begin once the Player has returned to the Restaurant/Bar area.
6. The bar tab will remain open for four hours or until a maximum bar tab of \$400 has been reached
7. There is a one drink limit per member.
8. No food may be charged against the bar tab.
9. The bar tab may only be open during the day of the hole-in-one.
10. In the event that insurance fund money is not used in the bar (Example: \$400 limit less the bar tab of \$220=\$180) will be credited to the member's account in the form of Pro Shop credits.

Guidelines

All eligible rounds (including 9 holes) must be posted to the GHIN system after play. Certain tournament rounds will be posted by the Pro Shop. See Handicaps on next page for details.

All golfers must check in with the Pro Shop upon arrival to confirm tee time and partners as well as preference for walking, pull cart or riding cart.

No group will hold its place on the tee unless all its members are ready to play when called.

An email account forwarding to the tournament committee has been established to encourage constructive suggestions and comment, on the golf course, tournament schedule or any other aspect of the golfing program. tournamentcommittee@hopkintoncc.com

Hopkinton Country Club depends on its members to dress in good taste.

Golfer's shirts must have collars. T-shirts, tank tops, gym shorts, short shorts, cutoffs and denim of any kind are considered inappropriate apparel for the golf course and may not be worn. If a hat is worn it should be forward facing.

Soft spike golf shoes must be worn at all times.

Hats may only be worn downstairs. Hats are not permitted in the Grill Room, members lounge and dining areas at any time. Same for cell phone use.

Member golfers and their guests may NOT start on the 10th tee without Pro Shop permission.

Member golfers and their guests may NOT STOP before teeing off on the 10th hole to eat. Please use call box at the number nine tee to order food to go for back nine play. A water cooler will be available at the 10th tee. **Pace of play must be observed as a courtesy to all members. An 18-hole round for a foursome should be completed within 4 hours and 10 minutes.**

Tee Time Policies

Tee times may be made 7 days prior to desired date through either the ForeTees service, phone, or in person at the Pro Shop.

All members are responsible for knowing any restrictions that may apply to their membership categories related to tee times.

Single players may be paired up, as well as twosomes during peak play periods. Usually two players minimum are required to reserve a tee time. Please check ForeTees for weather delays.

Limited Golf Member Tee Time Policy

Limited members may tee off AFTER 11:00 a.m. on weekends and holidays, and BEFORE 11:00 a.m. and AFTER 1:00 p.m. on Fridays. As of Thursday each week if there are open tee times between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on the weekend, limited golfers may reserve them by calling the Pro Shop.

Junior Golf Members (16-26) Tee Time Policy

Junior Golf members may tee off AFTER 11:00 a.m. on weekends and holidays and BEFORE 11:00 a.m. and AFTER 1:00 p.m. on Fridays. Single players will be paired up, as well as twosomes during peak play periods. As of Thursday each week if there are open tee times between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on the weekend, junior golfers may reserve them by calling the Pro Shop.

Children Golf Members (7-15) Tee Time Policy

Children members may tee off AFTER 3:00 p.m. on weekends and holidays and BEFORE 11:00 a.m. and AFTER 1:00 p.m. on Fridays. All children golf members must be accompanied by parent or guardian, unless golf "etiquette" approved and certified by an HCC Golf Professional.

Child Golfer Certification Program

All children members with an orange bag tag must be accompanied by a parent on the course. A test is offered in the Spring for child golfers to receive a green bag tag and be certified to golf unaccompanied. Please speak with the Pro shop for further details.

Guest Policy

A GUEST MAY PLAY ONLY ONCE PER CALENDAR MONTH.

A member with multiple guests must play AFTER 10:00 a.m. on weekends and holidays and BEFORE 11:00 a.m. and AFTER 1:00 p.m. on Fridays. One guest maximum allowed per foursome before 10:00 a.m. on weekends and holidays.

Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests including adherence to HCC policies regarding dress and cell phone use.

Carts

Use of golf carts, both power and hand, is subject to daily permission of the Pro Shop and is primarily dependent on course and weather conditions.

Only licensed drivers may operate golf carts.

A cart should not be driven in muddy areas or through puddles of water or in any place that might injure the turf or native grasses.

Wherever possible, golf carts should remain on cart paths. Deviation should follow the 90 degree rule. **The 90 degree rule is defined as a cart that should be driven along cart path to a point directly opposite the ball. After the shot is hit the cart returns to the path along the same route.**

All members are responsible for the actions (cart rule violations) of any guest he/she brings to the club.

The limit of two persons to a cart is to be observed and speed should be limited.

A golf cart should not be driven in wooded areas and never under low tree limbs.

The cart directional signs are to be observed at all times. **THIS IS A MUST!**

A golf cart should not be driven within 15 yards of any green!

Golf carts must stop before crossing roads and may not be driven along public roads.

Operation of a golf cart in a dangerous or reckless manner may result in revocation of golf cart driving privileges.

Handicaps

All handicaps shall be computed in accordance with the Regulations prescribed by the United States Golf Association and shall promulgate such other regulations as shall from time to time be deemed appropriate.

All members are required to post their Equitable Stroke Control (ESC) adjusted score for all rounds played. If 7-12 holes are played, post a 9-hole score; if more holes are played, post an 18-hole score, recording a score of par plus any index-applicable handicap strokes for the holes not played. ESC sets a maximum number that a player can post on any hole depending on the player's course handicap. Please refer to the charts posted in the Pro Shop for more information or refer to the USGA website at www.USGA.org. Scores may be posted on the score posting computer or ForeTees system or online at www.GHIN.com. There are 9 tournaments that will be posted only by the Pro Shop, see below. Other than these 9 tournaments, each member is responsible for posting their own scores to the GHIN system within one week as per the club's handicap policy. ESC is an adjustment of individual hole scores (for handicap purposes) in order to make handicaps more representative of a player's potential ability. ESC is applied after the round and is only used when the actual score or the most likely score exceeds a player's maximum allowed score for a hole. ESC sets a limit to the number of strokes a player can take on a hole depending on their Course Handicap. Apply ESC to all scores, including tournament scores. Following is the maximum number a player can take:

Course Handicap	Maximum Number
9 or less	Double Bogey
10 - 19	7
20 - 29	8
30 - 39	9
40 and above	10

The Pro Shop only posts the scores for the below listed tournaments. Each player must immediately turn in a completed, signed and attested score card.

- Men's and Ladies Club Championship
- Men's and Ladies Member-Member
- Men's and Ladies Senior Club Championship
- Ladies Member-Guest

The Handicap Committee has modified the procedure to follow when posting off-season scores. No round played in Massachusetts during the off-season may be counted towards your handicap index, designated by the MGA to run from November 15th thru March. Members playing in an area that is in-season (e.g. Florida) while HCC is off-season, should only post scores for rounds played with an HCC member, turning in the signed and attested score card to the scoreboard box by the posting computer., unless the HCC playing member is also a member of the course played (e.g. Florida).

Failure to post a score may result in a penalty posting and/or disqualification from handicapped tournaments, as determined by the Handicap Committee.

New Local Handicap Rules From 2016 Approved By Golf Committee

General:

- Handicap Chair, after review and majority approval from Golf Committee, reserve the right to make handicap adjustments as required. Communication to committee can be email-based for expediency.

Men's League:

- There will be a flight where no strokes are distributed (minimum of 6 teams) - black tees
- Prior year flight winners will play at lower of current handicap or lowest handicap recorded over the period of the prior year league and cannot increase their handicap over the course of the current league. However, they can go lower based on postings. Handicap chair will be fully responsible for communicating to Pro Shop the correct handicaps during Men's league season. Handicap chair will also be responsible for communicating adjusted handicaps directly to participants.
- One week deadline for participants to post 9 hole ESC score from league on a week by week basis. Failure to post on a timely basis will result in a 1st written warning from the handicap chair. If after an additional week, score is still not posted, a penalty posting of lowest 9 hole score of last 20 rounds will be posted by handicap chair. In the event the participant has only played 18 hole matches, the lowest 18 hole score divided in half over the last 20 rounds will be posted to the appropriate front or back side, depending on which side the participant was scheduled to play that week.

Men's 3-Day Member Guest:

- Tournament committee will audit guest handicaps and has a right to make changes as seen fit to protect the field and all associated betting.

Men's Member-Member:

- Tournament committee will audit handicaps and has a right to make changes as seen fit to protect the field and all associated personal wagering.

Weekly Stablefords:

- Weekly cash winners have one week deadline to post 18 hole ESC score. Failure to post on a timely basis will result in a 1st written warning from the handicap chair. If after an additional week, score is still not posted, a penalty posting of lowest 18 hole score of last 20 rounds will be posted by handicap chair. All scorecards must be turned in to Pro Shop for official results.

Other:

- Additional added April Spring Opener tournament that has a 6-6-6 format 2-man alt shot, 2-man scramble and 2-man best ball.

Practice Facility Rules and Regulations

Operating hours will be posted outside the Pro Shop. Only golf members and their guests have Range Privileges.

Junior Golf members (with green bag tags) are restricted to the following hours: (usually follow allowed tee times)

- Weekends and holidays after 11:00 a.m.
- Fridays before 10:00 a.m. and after 2:00 p.m.
- NO THURSDAY NIGHTS after 4:00 p.m. in May and June
- Family practice range area (shortgame) - yellow balls only

All juniors must first register at the Pro Shop prior to range use.

The North end of the range near the 17th green is for **full golf members only**. When the North end is in use, there may be distance restrictions placed. Please observe these restrictions for safety concerns. Social members may use the range on a per day basis for \$15.

General Tournament Guidelines

United States Golf Association Rules of Golf govern all tournament play unless superseded by local rules.

All tournaments registrations will be concluded by the tournament deadline. The Golf Committee reserves the right to change, cancel or postpone any scheduled event. Rain dates will be announced when necessary unless otherwise noticed in the Official Schedule of Golf Events. The Tournament Committee shall set entry fees for all tournaments and announce the same as soon as practical.

All golfers MUST have an official handicap, as approved by the Handicap Committee, to be eligible for most tournaments. New golfers need only 5 rounds to establish a handicap.

The Golf Professional Staff, the Golf Committee and official designees will make decisions on all questions pertaining to the "Rules of Golf."

Rules and Etiquette of Golf

The Rules of Golf as published annually by the United States Golf Association shall apply. Any modifying Local Rules shall be listed on the current score card or Club bulletin boards.

Practice on the golf course or regular greens is prohibited. Practice shall be strictly limited to the designated practice areas as well as the driving range.

Players shall keep golf bags and carts off greens and out of sand traps. Riding carts shall not be driven within fifteen yards of any green.

Cutting in is forbidden.

Reports of violations of any golf rule or regulation must be made in writing and signed by the complaining member and submitted to a member of the Golf Committee. The report should be specific including time, date and circumstances. If other members observed the violation, they should be asked to sign the letter noting the violation. The Committee at its discretion may hold a hearing on the alleged violation and make recommendations for appropriate sanctions, which could include a written warning or suspension of golf privileges.

All players are expected to replace turf, repair ball marks, smooth sand traps, and deposit all rubbish in receptacles.

At no time should the use of cell phones interfere with the pace of play. If a cell phone is taken on the golf course, it must be on vibrate or silent mode. Violation of these rules could result in suspension of golf privileges. Cell phone use is allowed in the parking lot and the downstairs areas of the Clubhouse only.

In case of a Tie: tie breakers; a match of cards if needed for final placings.
Net Tournament - from #1 stroke hole, etc.
Gross Tournament - hole #1, etc.
All Plaque Champions - a playoff

Most importantly, LEARN THE RULES OF GOLF.

Local Rules

Local Rules will be posted on the wall outside the Pro Shop.

All Boundary walls are considered out of bounds. The dividing stone wall between holes 15 and 16 up to the 16th green, is considered a manmade immovable obstruction which entitles players to a free drop. Other rock walls along the course are boundary markers and are considered out-of-bounds.

All French drains, irrigation lines and areas damaged by water runoff are considered ground under repair.

All mulched areas are part of the course (unless designated as a beautification area with blue stakes) and the ball is played as it lies. Relief is granted only as permitted by the Rules of Golf.

All beautification areas are marked by blue stakes and are mandatory relief, one club length no closer to the hole without penalty.

Modified Stableford Scoring System

The Golf Committee has determined that the Modified Stableford Scoring System will be utilized for all tournaments and weekend events as dictated by the Golf Committee and the Pro Shop. Except for the Players Cup, which utilizes the Point Quota System.

Stableford competitions are forms of stroke play in which play is against a fixed score at each hole. Scoring is as follows:

Hole Played In	Points
Double Bogey and above	0
Bogey	1
Par	2
Birdie	3
Eagle	4
Albatross	5
Condor	6

Handicaps may be used as determined by the Golf Committee for Modified Stableford Scoring with strokes falling on the card as determined by the handicap of each competitor.

For example if a competitor pars a hole and receives a stroke based on handicap, his or her Net score is a birdie and the competitor is awarded three points.

The winners are determined by the competitor who scores the highest number of points.

All Modified Stableford play will follow Rule 32 governing Stableford play as defined by the United States Golf Association unless superseded by local rules.

Beverage Cart

Weather permitting: The BAeverage Cart will be available during most Club golf tournaments as well as the Men's Thursday night league and the Ladies Tuesday night league (as appropriate).

In Season (Memorial Day - Labor Day) the Beverage Cart will also be available on the course daily from 11:00 a.m. until dusk.

Criteria for playing tees forward of the stipulated tournament tees for Handicapped Tournaments only (Net scores)

- 65 years of age or older, or having a disability that qualifies for handicapped parking.
- Handicap is calculated according to USGA. Note that course handicap is relative to a scratch golfer (the course rating) and not to par. Differences in course ratings between the forward and tournament tees are included. Priority Criteria for 3-Day Member/Guest, Player's Cup, Men's Thursday night league, if registered by event entry deadline

First, all players MUST be registered by the deadline

For the 3-day Member/Guest and Player's Cup:

- (a) Automatic spot if you played in prior year's event if registered by deadline
- (b) Played in the event at least 2 out of the previous 4 years
- (c) Was waitlisted in prior year's event but did not get to play
- (d) Everyone else
- (e) Lottery for open spots within each category (b) to (d) above

For Men's Thursday night league:

- (a) Automatic spot if team played as a team last year and registered by deadline or both team members played last year but on different teams
- (b) One team member played in prior year
- (c) Played as alternate in prior year
- (d) Everyone else
- (e) Lottery for open spots within each category (b) to (d) above

This is an opportunity to play with a Pro in a best ball, fourball format. It is for women and men. Signup sheet is in the Pro Shop. This is a season-long event, with prizes, for both Gross and Net, based on 80% course handicap. Fee is \$30 per round. See Pro Shop for more details.

Family Golf Nights are held most Saturdays, starting April 9 through November. This program allows for any family member to golf with their family, after 4:00 p.m. (Check calendar and ForeTees tee time sign up system). This requires ForeTees sign up and play must be with at least one full golfing member.

This golf is **FREE** and is to help introduce non-golfers (children and spouses) to the wonderful game. This has been highly successful over the recent years. Special tees are set up for children; if needed, ask for more details in the Pro Shop. Look for the Junior tee markers on the front nine for younger juniors and children. Play a few holes or nine and take the family to the Grill Room afterwards.

DATE: Every Thursday night from April 14 through June 30. Shotgun at 5:15 p.m. There will be no league on April 21 due to school vacation.

ENTRY DEADLINE: End of day Sunday April 3 through ForeTees only. Priority sign up based upon prior years team participants in full. Individuals who sign up to play seeking a partner are assigned by the Pro Shop or sign up with another prior year participant but were not a team will have secondary priority. See priority criteria in rules section of this book. ALL DECISIONS MADE BY THE PRO SHOP ARE FINAL.

FORMAT: Two-man best ball nine-hole match play based on Net score utilizing 90% course handicap.

ELIGIBILITY: All full men's golf members

ENTRY FEE: \$160 per player (Carts - optional for an additional fee)

INCLUDES: Weekly refreshments, attendance draw, and end of league dinner buffet

SCORING: Two man best ball 9-hole match play based on Net score utilizing 90% USGA course handicap. 9-hole match play, wins are worth 1 point per hole, ties are worth ½ point. The final week or two of play will be playoffs, with results counting towards cumulative league scoring. The team with the most cumulative points in their flight at the end of league play are champions of their flight.

Maximum points per match for winning team capped at 7, assuming both teams fully participate. All points must be earned, meaning losing 8 to 1 earns the losing team only 1 point.

Two-man teams playing against a one-man team or no competitors will play out their round and have their results compared to a "blind draw" of a losing two-man team or losing one-man participant, as applicable. Two-man "blind draw" teams cannot earn any points for the team they have been drawn to represent. One-man blind draw teams will be capped at four (4) points, unless playing member individually earns more points.

Alternate players play at 80% of the 90% course handicap. Teams are responsible for finding alternate players, NOT THE PRO SHOP! Alternates play at 50% handicap for playoffs. If there are two alternates for a team in a week, then they will be capped at five (5) points and the competing team must earn any points. Players that are injured and out for the season, may be replaced at 90% for the substituting player.

ALL score cards are to be properly scored, attested and IMMEDIATELY submitted to the scorer's table upon completion of round. ALL scores must be posted by participant with a deadline of next week's match. Failure to properly complete a score card will result in a penalty posting as determined by the Handicap Committee.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Failure of team participants to show up for a weekly match or find alternate players two times during the league season results in disqualification of participation in future years.

Men's Singles Challenge Cup

ENTRY DEADLINE: Sunday, April 17 through ForeTees only.

FORMAT: There will be no qualifying round. All players that sign up will be seeded. Matches will be seeded by previous year's results and there is the possibility of byes if more than 64 players sign up to play. Played from green tees.

ELIGIBILITY: All full men's golf members

ENTRY FEE: \$40 per player (Carts - optional for an additional fee) Note: no consolation bracket

SCORING: 100% Match Play

For this tournament the Pro Shop only posts the scores. Each Player must immediately turn in a completed, signed and attested score card.

MATCH PLAY FORMAT: 18-hole matches from the **green tees** at 100% USGA course handicap. This is a single elimination competition. Ties after 18 holes continues from the first hole in a "sudden death" format.

MATCH PLAY DATE DEADLINE:
Match 1 to be completed by the end of May
Match 2 to be completed by the end of June
Match 3 to be completed by the end of July
Match 4 to be completed by the end of August
Match 5 to be completed by the end of September
Match 6 to be completed by October 16
Championship Match completed by October 31

TOURNAMENT RULINGS: All matches MUST be completed by the deadline date posted. The Golf committee has the unilateral authority to decide on match winners on any match not completed by the deadlines posted. If a scheduling issue is encountered and a solution cannot be worked out amongst participants, you are encouraged to immediately contact the tournament committee through the Pro Shop to state your case to avoid determination of winner by tournament committee. Decisions made by the tournament committee are UNILATERAL and FINAL. You must find a way to accommodate the deadlines above. Making the rest of the field wait has proven to be unworkable. Participants are strongly encouraged to work out scheduling conflicts among themselves or outcome of the pending match will be decided by a coin flip by the tournament committee.

Rule decisions required as a result of the actual match on the golf course will be resolved by the Head Club Professional or the Assistant Club Professional the day the match is played.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Cancellations after Sunday, April 23 will result in a 100% forfeiture of the entry fee.

Gilfoy Four Ball Challenge Cup

This tournament is named after Pete Gilfoy, former member and champion of first annual tournament, who passed away in 2007.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Sunday, April 17 through ForeTees only.

ENTRANCE RULES: All teams signed up will be placed into a match play elimination bracket tournament. Matches will be seeded by previous year's results and there is the possibility of byes if more than 32 teams sign up to play.

FLIGHTS: Two flights will be established by the pro shop. 1/2 of the teams will be put in the Black flight (playing from the black tees) and 1/2 of the teams will be put in the Blue flight (playing from the blue tees).

The winners of the Blue flight will compete with winners of the Black flight for the Championship match. The Championship match shall be played from the green tees.

ELIGIBILITY: All full men's golf members.

ENTRY FEE: \$40 per player (Carts - optional for an additional fee) Note: no consolation bracket

SCORING: In the four-ball, Net match play, two competitors play as partners, each playing his own ball. The lower Net score of the two partners is the score for the hole for that team. If one partner fails to complete the play of a hole, there is no penalty.

For this tournament the Pro Shop only posts the scores. Each Player must immediately turn in a completed, signed and attested score card.

MATCH PLAY FORMAT: 18-hole matches at 90% USGA course handicap. Opening match winners continue in winner's bracket under single elimination play. Ties after 18 holes continues from the first hole in a "sudden death" format.

MATCH PLAY DATE DEADLINE:

- Match 1 to be completed by the end of May
- Match 2 to be completed by the end of June
- Match 3 to be completed by the end of July
- Match 4 to be completed by the end of August
- Match 5 to be completed by the end of September
- Championship Match completed by October 31 - this played from green tees

TOURNAMENT RULINGS: All matches MUST be completed by the deadline date posted. The Golf committee sponsors have the unilateral authority to decide the match winners on any match not completed by the deadlines posted. If a scheduling issue is encountered a solution must be worked out between the participants. Failure to do so will result in your match being decided by a coin flip by the Golf committee. Decisions made by the Golf committee are UNILATERAL and FINAL. You must find a way to accommodate the deadlines above. Making the rest of the field wait has proven to be unworkable.

Rule decisions required as a result of the actual match on the golf course will be resolved by the Head Club Professional or the Assistant Club Professional the day the match is played.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Cancellations after Sunday, April 23 will result in a 100% forfeiture of the entry fee.

Spring Opener 6-6-6

DATE: Saturday, April 30: 2-player teams

FORMAT: 6 holes selected drive alternate shot; 6 holes 2-person scramble; 6 holes best ball. Gross and net prizes. Tee times. Buffet included post round. Men and women welcome.

ENTRY FEE: \$60 per player

Ladies Tuesday Night League

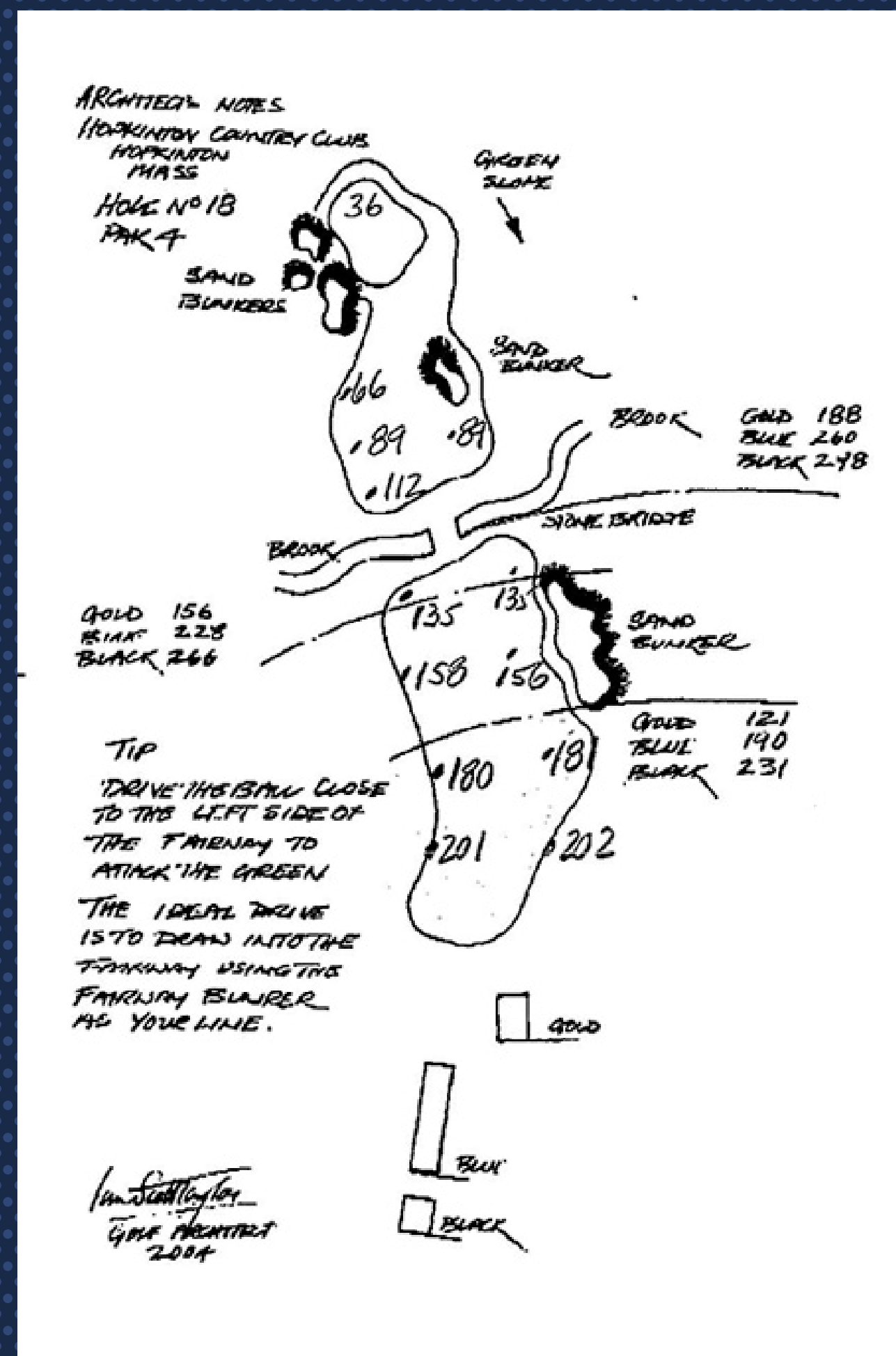

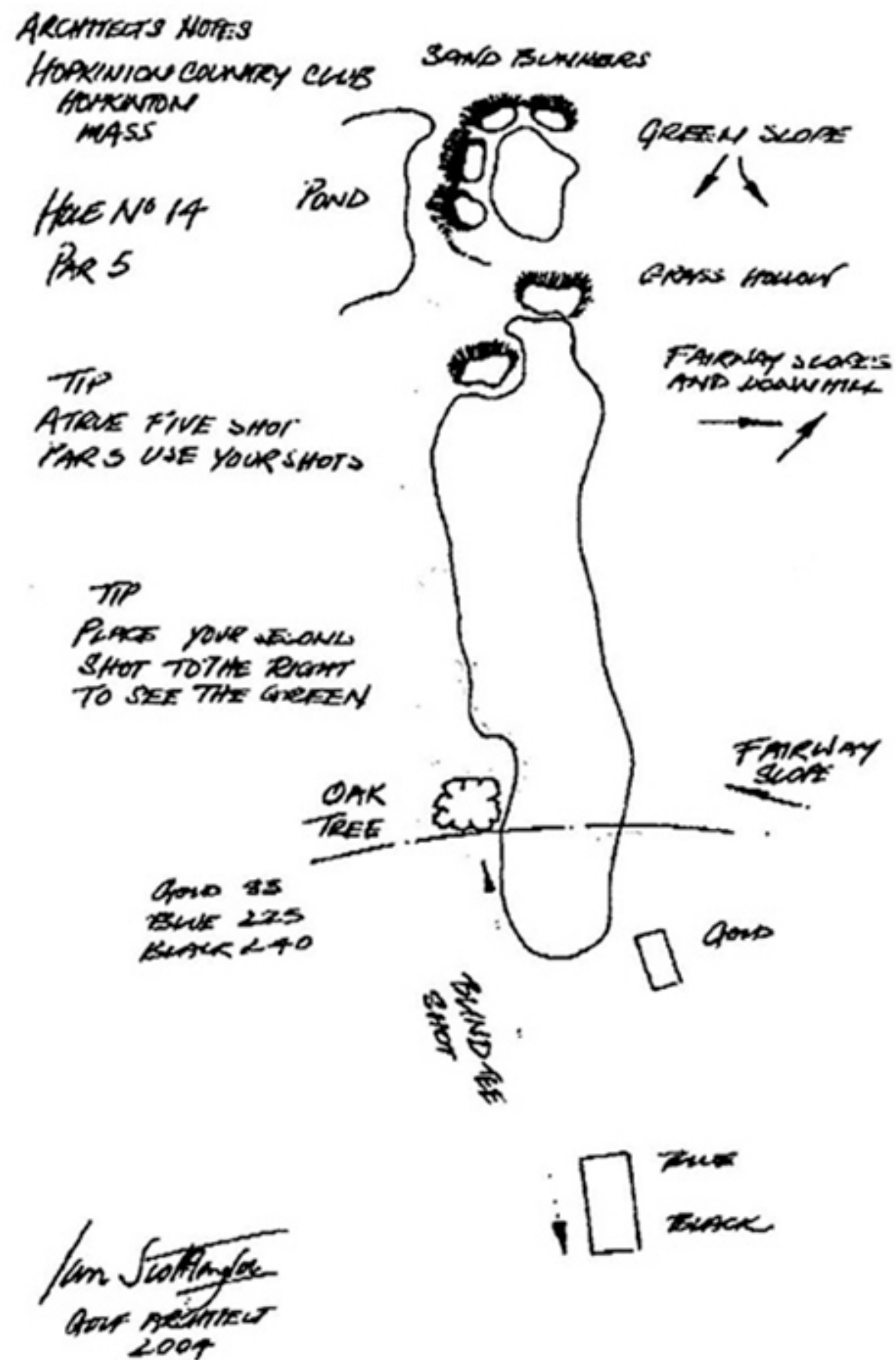

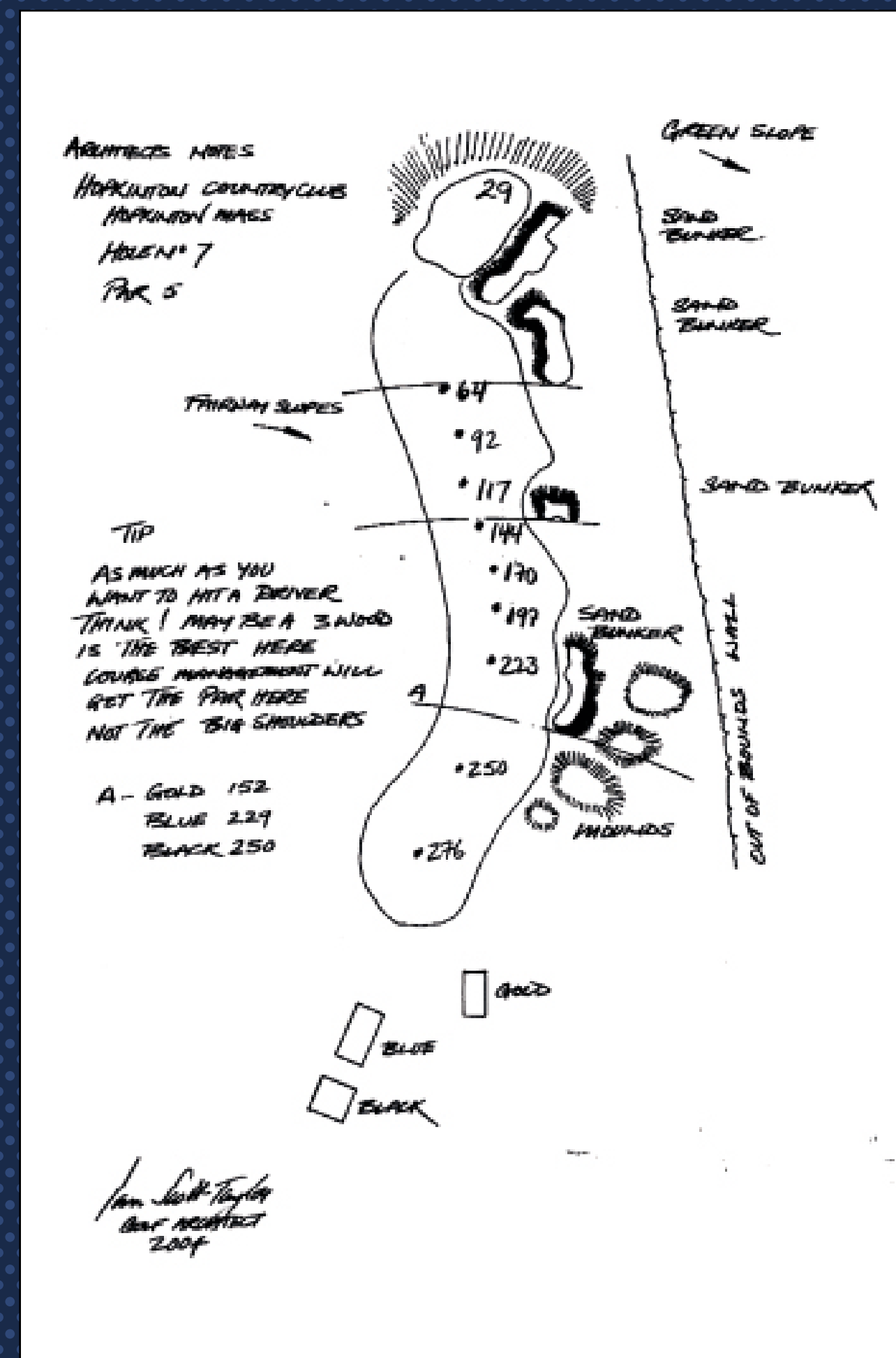
